Perinatal Counselling

CrossReach Perinatal Service supports those struggling with the impact of perinatal difficulties (PND). We offer therapeutic support to families experiencing distress in the perinatal period, during pregnancy and up until their youngest child is two years old, through group work and individual counselling and psychotherapy counselling.

Responsibilities and Duties

Assist Senior Crèche Worker to create a welcoming, safe, secure & stimulating environment, appropriate for children aged 0-5 years. To support & nurture each child as an individual. To care sensitively & respectfully for the unique needs of each child, promoting positive behaviour. To continue to evaluate & implement the guidelines as lay down by the Care Commission. To promote an overall sense of fun & learning with all children, through the use of creative Play, Arts & Music.

Qualifications and Skills

The crèche is recognised as a central provision of the service and involves caring for babies and infants up to school age, whilst their parent attends normally one hour per week therapy or 1 ½ hour group work. We look for a high degree of professionalism and compassion in our work with vulnerable families. Some experience in attending to babies and infants is required.
