Our Perinatal Service supports those struggling with the impact of perinatal difficulties (PND). As a qualified baby massage, volunteering with us will give you the chance to be part of a friendly team and enable you to use and develop your skills in a supportive environment. Your generous volunteering time will bring huge benefits to the families who use our Bluebell Perinatal Service.

## **Role Description**

Bluebell's qualified baby massage volunteers use their unique therapy skills and expertise to create a safe, enjoyable and calm space for mothers and their babies (age 0-6months).

#### Main Tasks

Setting up the baby massage room

- Welcoming all those who use baby massage
- Creating and maintaining a safe, sensitive therapeutic environment for the mothers and their babies
- Supporting the mothers through the baby massage
- Maintaining Bluebell's codes of confidentiality and conduct (including Health and Safety)

## Required skills, qualifications and experience

• We are looking for volunteers who can commit to up to three hours on a Monday afternoon

#### **Recruitment process:**

**Application** – please request an application form via email. Your application will be screened and we will be in touch if you are to be invited for an informal chat.

**Informal Chat** - This is an opportunity for you to get a feel for how our Bluebell Service works and gives us a chance to get to know you. We will let you know, normally within a week, if you have been successful in joining the Bluebell Baby Massage volunteer team.





#### Induction and supervision:

- **Bluebell Training:** Understanding Perinatal Mood Disorders We offer all our volunteers the opportunity to complete a <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> day CPD session. Leaflet attached
- Induction Session: If you are offered a place on the Bluebell team you will be invited to an Induction Session. Again you will have a chance to visit the centre, we will also get all documentation completed, including PVGs. Please note it can take about 6 weeks for PVGs to come through. Once everything is in order, you will be part of our Bluebell team and start volunteering with Bluebell.
- Expenses: Reasonable travel expenses will be reimbursed
- **Supervision**: Regular opportunity to discuss your volunteering experience with management team
