The three days will explore:

How we feel about bringing love and sex into the counselling room and how we deal with our own feelings; our client's feelings; and what emerges between us.

These days can be for those wishing to expand their counselling repertoire into talking about sex and love and also as a refresher for those who already do so in their counselling practice.

Day One - Saturday 6 July - will explore how we talk to clients about sex and love; the feelings it provokes in us and how we manage the boundaries. We will explore the significance of erotic transference and how this can enhance both our understanding and the quality of our work.

Day 2 – Saturday 27 July - is a knowledge-based day where we explore the basics of sex and how we talk to clients about sexual feelings and difficulties. Sex is always present in counselling, just sometimes, we choose to ignore it. This day will give you the information and confidence to start those conversations with clients.

Day 3 – Saturday 3 August - will look at the impact of pornography on the individual and on relationships.

The days will be facilitated by Anne Chilton and Janet Brown. The days are stand-alone so you can attend one, two or all three events.

Aims of the days are to:

- To explore how we talk to clients about sex and love;
- To understand the feelings it provokes in us and how we manage the boundaries.
- To explore the significance of erotic transference and how this can enhance both our understanding and the quality of our work.

Day 2 - Saturday 27 July - "Working with Love and Sex"

- To explore the basics of sex and how we talk to clients about sexual feelings and difficulties.
- To give you the information and confidence to start those conversations with clients about sex.

Day 3 - Saturday 3 August - "Love, Sex and Porn Uncomfortable Bedfellows?"

- To look at the impact of pornography on the individual
- To also look at the impact of pornography on relationships.

Presenters: Anne Chilton has been a practicing therapist for nearly 40 years. She works with couples and individuals and has a specialism in working with sexual difficulties. She currently runs the Relationships Scotland Diploma in Sex and Relationship Therapy which is the first fully validated training in Scotland.

Janet Brown is an experienced Counsellor, Supervisor and trainer. She is currently the Course director of the Certificate in Couple Counselling, Relationships Scotland.
