## Relationships Scotland Diploma in Casework Supervision

This is a part-time Supervision Diploma for experienced counsellors, who hold at least a Diploma in Counselling. It is designed to give a thorough grounding in individual supervision, and to provide specific skills in supervising couple counsellors and groups.

The course has conditional validation from COSCA and is one of the main routes toward Supervisor Registration with Relationships Scotland.

### Length of Course:

The course consists of 6 weekends, spread over 10 months.

### Venue:

The course will take place online initially, with a view returning to face to face training at Relationships Scotland National Office, 18 York Place, Edinburgh, EH1 3EP.

**\*Access:** there are four steps at the front and two at the rear of York Place. The training room is on the first floor. We have a small lift which runs from the ground floor to the third floor and that cannot be used in the event of fire. If you experience any difficulty with mobility, or if there is anything else that could inhibit your participation in this training, and you wish to discuss your access needs, please do not hesitate to contact us.

\*Specialist topics include working with relationship and sexual issues, power and authority, and group dynamics.

## **Placements:**

Applicants from the Relationships Scotland network who wish to supervise within a Member service will require the support of the Member service manager. Applicants from outwith the network should have their placement approved by the Course Leader.

## **Supervisee requirement:**

Each participant needs to have at least two supervisees and is required to deliver 27 hours of supervised practice in order to complete the course. It is necessary to have supervisees early in place for the beginning of the course, so that participants have practice experience as the course progresses. The final date for completion of the 27 hours of practice is August 2022 one year after the end of the taught part of the course.

## **Consultant supervision:**

Applicants need a minimum of 4 hours of consultant supervision for their practice, during the length of the course.

## **Cost:**

£1872 Payment by instalments can be arranged.

## **Selection:**

Selection is by application form, and by one individual interview which will be held online.
