The post holder will also contribute to the wider range of services including the delivery of psycho-educational workshops, service promotion and referrals to relevant resources, services and agencies. They will maintain professional standards by receiving supervision for clinical work participate in ongoing professional development activities and keep client records in accordance with the following organisations British Association of counselling and Psychotherapy (BACP) Ethical Framework for Good Practice in Counselling and Psychotherapy. or (COSCA) Counselling & Psychotherapy in Scotland, Statement of Ethics & Code of Practice.

Ideally, candidates would have substantial post qualified experience of counselling delivery in a university setting allied to excellent interpersonal skills and the ability to work flexibly within a team environment and manage competing demands.

Additionally, the Service is looking for individuals who are committed to personal and professional development both for themselves and for the clients they serve.
