

Job Title: Befriending Co-ordinator

Role:

The Befriending Co-ordinator will be responsible for the day to day planning, co-ordination and delivery of a befriending service to support survivors who access GCA's wellbeing services across Glasgow and are most at risk from addictions, homelessness, social isolation and poverty. The Befriending Co-ordinator will also recruit and train volunteer befrienders to provide support and encouragement for individuals who use GCA's wellbeing services, however struggle to stay engaged.

In return for choosing to work for GCA, the benefits you will receive are:

- Very generous annual leave entitlement: full time employees start with an annual leave entitlement of 37 days (inclusive of 12 bank holidays) which increases to 38 days after 2 years, 40 days after 5 years and 42 days after 10 years length of service.
