#### Role:

The Community Justice Support Worker will provide 121 support, topic based group work and prison through care in the wider community and primary care settings in Glasgow. The Community Justice Support Worker will also be responsible for the day-to-day delivery of the Community Justice Prison Through care programme including 1-1 meetings in prison and support for the client when liberated. There are various aspects of the programme which are aimed at supporting clients to fulfil a conduct or programme requirement as part of a Community Payback Order or Supervised Release Order, as well as offering a focused educational opportunity as directed under a supervising CJSW officer, Procurator Fiscal or Diversion from Prosecution. The Community Justice Support Worker will also be required to:

- Carry a client caseload.
- Liaise with other agencies, monitoring of services and contributing to the writing of reports.
- Facilitate group work.
- Complete paperwork and promptly update the database on all interactions with participants as well as recording outcomes and progressions.
- Carry out other duties in line with organisational requirements.
